PACKING LIST:

CAMPERS:

- USPC Medical Armband with CURRENT completed medical card
- Sleeping bag and air mattress/pad
- Towel for bathing /washcloths
- Bag for dirty linens
- Personal items (toothbrush, soap, comb, brush, etc)
- Sunscreen and Bug Spray
- ALL MEDICATIONS
- Hat/cap
- Several pairs of riding clothes (riding twice a day)
- Riding boots/Approved riding helmet
- Extra socks
- Undergarments
- Pajamas/slippers
- Sweatshirt/rain jacket
- Appropriate footwear for work around the barn and horses (Hard toe shoes must cover ankle and toes – **wearing tennis shoes is not allowed in the barn**)
- Shorts for 4 days (Campers are encouraged to change into shorts when not riding at the barn - also appropriate for evening activities)
- Polo shirts, sleeveless shirts with collar or collarless shirts with sleeves required for day and evening activities** (Example: sleeveless polo or tee shirt with sleeves - **Tank tops of any description are NOT allowed, no bare midriffs**)
- Small notebook/pen/pencil
- Book, magazine, cards or pocket games
- Flashlight/batteries
- Watch
- Refillable water bottles clearly marked with camper's name
- Folding chair (optional)
- Cooler with beverages for tackroom
- Cell phones
- GREAT ATTITUDE FOR LEARNING, MAKING NEW FRIENDS AND HAVING LOTS OF FUN! (REQUIRED)**

HORSE/PONY EQUIPMENT:

- Stall Card
- Feed and hay (label paper feedbags and consider need for extra hay since there is no turn out)
- 2 water buckets, 1 feed bucket, 1 top off 'fire' bucket
- Salt block
- Fly spray and fly mask (if you use)
- Necessary riding equipment for jumping, cross-country and dressage lessons
- Grooming kit
- Tack cleaning equipment
- Wash bucket, sweat scraper, sponge and towel
- Manure fork and bucket
