PACKING LIST:

CAMPERS:

- ☐ USPC Medical Armband with CURRENT completed medical card
- ☐ Sleeping bag and air mattress/pad
- ☐ Towel for bathing /washcloths
- ☐ Bag for dirty linens
- ☐ Personal items (toothbrush, soap, comb, brush, etc)
- ☐ Sunscreen and Bug Spray
- ☐ ALL MEDICATIONS
- ☐ Hat/cap
- ☐ Several pairs of riding clothes (riding twice a day)
- ☐ Riding boots/Approved riding helmet
- ☐ Extra socks
- ☐ Undergarments
- ☐ Pajamas/slippers
- ☐ Sweatshirt/rain jacket
- ☐ Appropriate footwear for work around the barn and horses (Hard toe shoes must cover ankle and toes – **wearing tennis shoes is not allowed in the barn**)
- ☐ Shorts for 4 days (Campers are encouraged to change into shorts when not riding at the barn - also appropriate for evening activities)
- ☐ **Polo shirts, sleeveless shirts with collar or collarless shirts with sleeves required for day and evening activities** (Example: sleeveless polo or tee shirt with sleeves - **Tank tops of any description are NOT allowed, no bare midriffs**)
- ☐ Small notebook/pen/pencil
- ☐ Book, magazine, cards or pocket games
- ☐ Flashlight/batteries
- ☐ Watch
- ☐ Refillable water bottles clearly marked with camper's name
- ☐ Folding chair (optional)
- ☐ Cooler with beverages for tackroom
